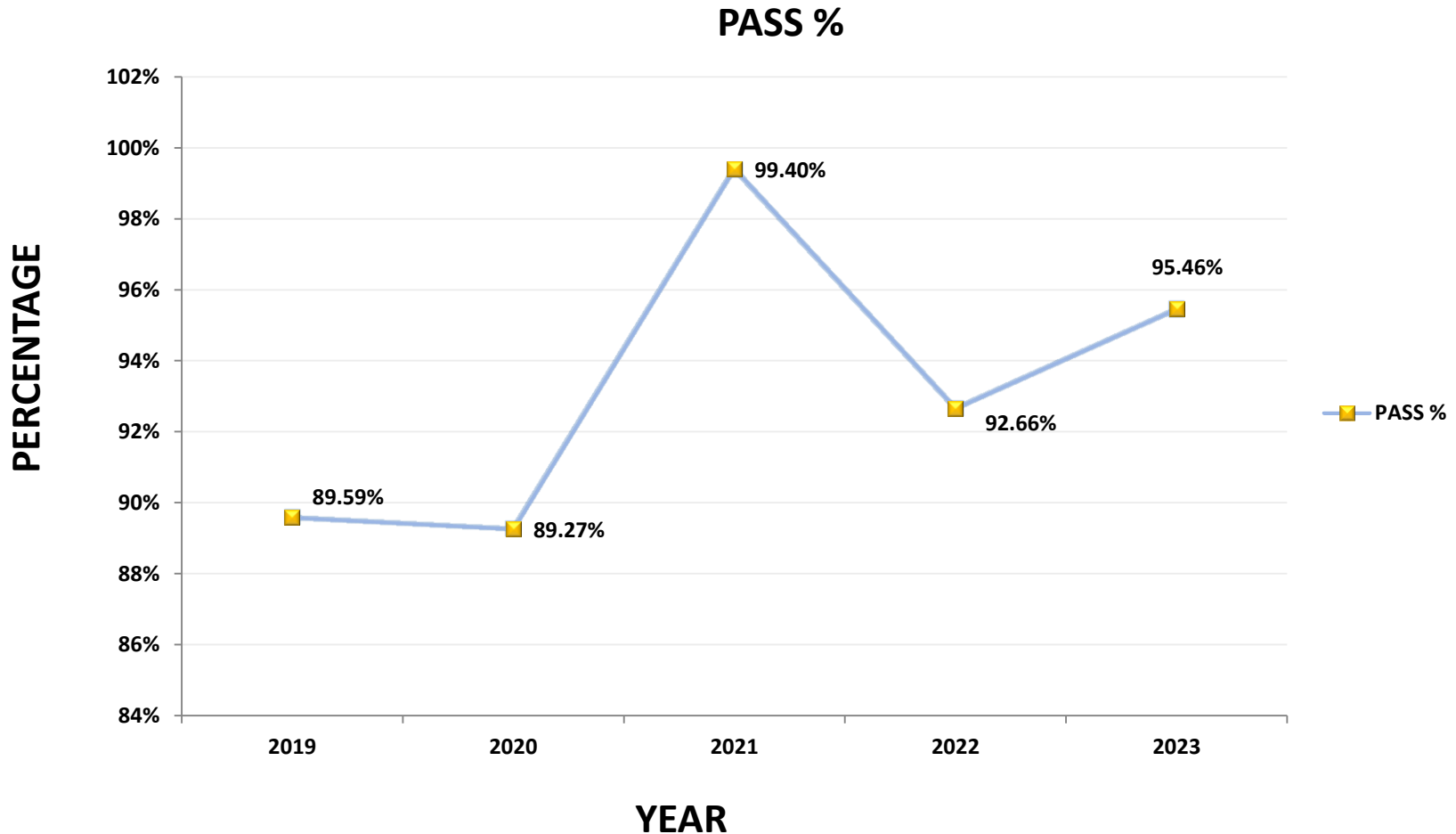

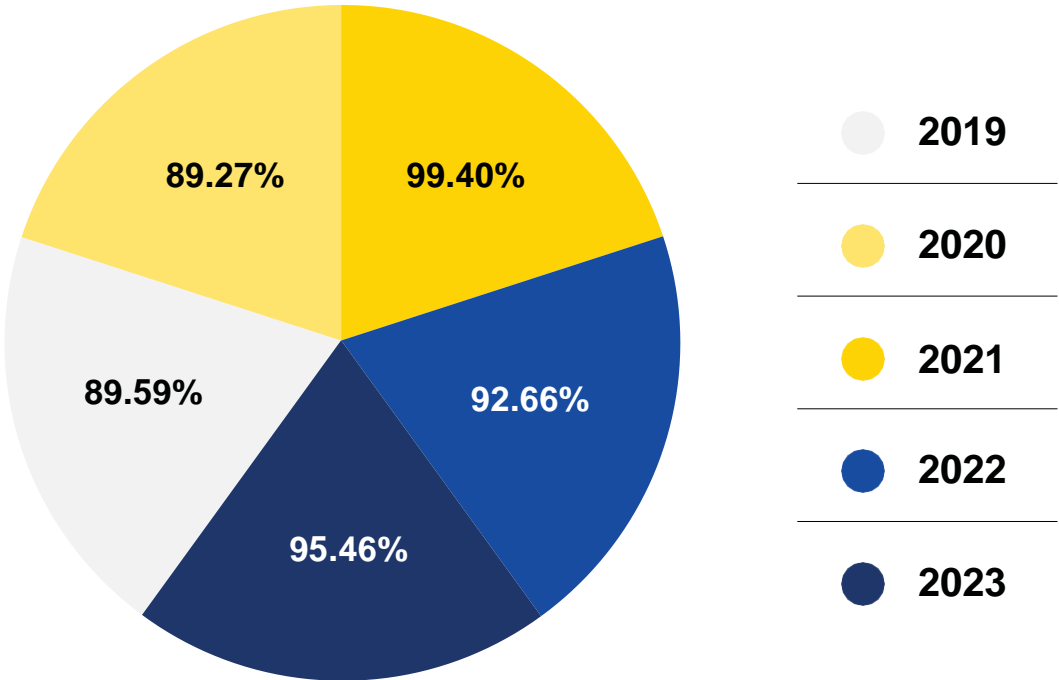
HSSC RESULTS FOR LAST FIVE YEARS
